

## “How to Listen for God’s Voice”

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All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work. (2 Timothy 3:16-17) NIV

1. Five Things for SOAP-ING
  - BIBLE: “All scripture is given by the inspiration of God.”
  - PEN/PENCIL: To notate verses God highlights to you.
  - JOURNAL: Take notes on what God is saying to you.
  - BIBLE READING PLAN: A clear path to follow.
  - DAILY PLANNER: Record non-related unfinished task.
  
2. S = SCRIPTURE
  - Read and Reflect upon the Scriptures.
  - Ask the LORD for one verse He wants to communicate to your heart today.
  - Write the Scripture in your journal.
  
3. O = OBSERVATION
  - Who is talking?
  - Who is being addressed?
  - What is the purpose?
  - What is happening?
  
4. A = APPLICATION
  - How does this verse apply to me?
  - Instruction?
  - Encouragement?
  - Promise?
  - Correction?
  
5. P = PRAYER
  - Ask for help to apply in your life.
  - Help for greater insight.
  - Praise and Thanksgiving
